Scratchboard Members' Workshop

The Scratchboard members' workshop given by Diane Cutter on Saturday, the 28th of August was for most a new and yet very interesting art form. The EEAG participants were Beverly Marshall, Beth McDonald, María Ramírez and Monica Sharpe. The workshop began at 9:00am and was held at Diane's home in Ceiba. Each student was provided a packet containing 2 3" x 5" black scratchboard panels with instructions (one for practice and one for our final product); a non-skid cloth to work on; a wooden handled, metal tipped, basic scratching tool; cotton to wipe away the black India ink scratched away from our panel; tracing paper to trace our design onto our panels; an informational pamphlet for ordering various scratch art supplies; and finally six different monochromatic, black and white designs to choose from as our model. There was a seagull in flight, a seagull standing, a fish, a stonework pattern, a tiger, and the moon. Once we all chose our model, Diane patiently guided us through each step of the scratchboard process. We first traced our design onto the scratchboard panel and then using the different tipped scratching tools provided on the work table, we began testing the result of each tip on our test panel and then carefully scratching out our new final works of art. After we were done with the scratching phase, the panels were sprayed with a couple of light coats of polyurethane. The workshop was followed by a very nice and relaxing lunch on the porch with an awesome ocean view, wonderful weather and quality conversation. We all went away wiser, fuller and glad we had come.
